This is a hand-written ledger book containing records pertaining to the care of the poor in the Town of Litchfield. It contains, but is not limited to, contracts between the Town of Litchfield and various Keepers of the Poor for the care of paupers within the Town; agreements for the support of specific individuals; agreements for the operation and management of the Town's Poor Farm; and records of the supplies purchased by various managers of the Poor Farm. It also contains numerous loose bills, etc.

Due to the arrangement of the book it is not indexed.

Historical Society of Litchfield, ME and was funded in part by the
Maine State Archives' Historical Records Collections Grant Program

1872 Town Poor Farm

April 1st Fred E Hutchinson and his wife Georgie Hutchinson are to serve as overseers on the town poor farm for one year. Both Fred & and his wife are to execute all due diligence in looking after the poor under their charge. And in their situation as overseers on the farm in looking after the interest of the town acting under the direction of the overseers of the poor. They are to furnish board and house room for Fred & and his wife and for their service rendered as above stated the town is to pay said Fred & and his wife for the year's service \$320.00 two hundred and twenty dollars in quarterly payment the first payment to be July 1st 1872 \$33.00 per quarter.
